Students receiving funding will receive up to \$750 to offset the hotel expenses at Commons Hotel (Conference Site) and registration fee. Travel grant is available to students and postdoctoral researchers from only US schools only since the grant is supported by US NSF.

## **Eligibility Requirements**

Any graduate student or a postdoctoral researcher from US schools may apply. Any recipient of a travel grant must register for the conference and workshops, and may be asked to help some conference/workshop events and/or registration desk as a volunteer. Awards will be made based on

- a) financial need to attend the conference and workshops,
- b) minority and under-represented students,
- c) students from historical under-represented and minority institutions,
- d) student authors presenting at the conference or workshops,

To apply, the student's advisor should send a one paragraph statement of financial need, student's progress toward graduation, student's CV, and research in areas related to ICPP.
